<u>Reading:</u>

Oral Reading Fluency (ORF)—On the ORF test your child will read 3 passages appropriate for his/her grade level for one minute. The teacher will calculate the words read correctly (Words correct—WC) and your child's accuracy rate. The median (middle) WC and accuracy will be used as your child's score on this test.

DAZE—The DAZE test is a measure of your child's ability to understand what he/she reads. This test is typically administered to the whole class at the same time. Your child will be asked to silently read a grade level passage for 3 minutes. A box containing the correct word and two "distracter" words has replaced every seventh word in the passage. Credit is given for each correct answer.

<u>Math:</u>

Computation (Comp.)—On the computation test your child is tested on his/her ability of basic skills of math computation. Your child is given 2 sheets and has 3 minutes to compete each sheet that contains grade level basic computation problems. Credit or points are given for each correct digit your child has in their answers to the problems. So, students are NOT penalized for the getting the whole problem wrong. Points are added up on each sheet and the average of the two sheets make up the final score.
